



The Team Support Leader...

High Adventure 2009 will give Explorers the opportunity to compete in an exciting outdoor event. The challenge will take place at a secret location in the UK. Team Support Leaders are there to accompany their teams and ensure they have the best experience possible. This information sheet details the role of the Team Support Leader accompanying Explorer Scout teams to High Adventure 2009.

As Team Support Leaders will be responsible for their team of five or six Explorer Scouts they must be over the age of 18 and have the permission of the team's Explorer Scout Leader.

The role of the Team Support Leader is...

- To assist the Explorer Scout Leader in ensuring that teams are adequately prepared for the event. Information regarding training and equipment is available from the organising committee via highadventure@leics-scout.org.uk
- To travel with their team to the secret destination.
- To help set up and take down team tents and equipment at the base camp.
- To ensure their teams are prepared for the challenge on Saturday with all the correct equipment.
- To assist the organising committee in setting up challenges that will be run on the Sunday (this will be done on the Saturday - all equipment and training will be provided by High Adventure Staff).
- To assist the organising committee in the running challenges on the Sunday.
- To ensure their team is looked after when they finish / retire from the competition and return to base camp.
- To travel with their team back to Leicestershire.
- To assist the organising committee in running the base camp.
- To ensure that their team reports to the start line at the correct time.
- To ensure they have sufficient spare kit to replace any kit lost / forgotten by their team (teams without the full kit list will not be permitted to start for safety reasons).

During the event, Team Support Leaders will camp at the base camp and will have access to all the facilities at this site. The application fee also includes food during the event.
